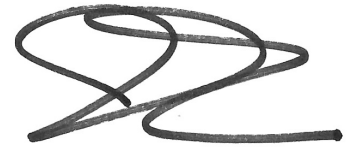

TEACHING EXPERIENCE

Adjunct Professor, University of New Haven, West Haven, CT 2016 - Present

ART1101: Introduction to Art through comprehensive study of foundation elements and principles. Lecture/studio in drawing, painting, print making and sculpture.

- Topics covered: point, line, plane, shape, texture, value and contrast, composition, color theory, Gestalt elements, unity and variety, balance, weight, gravity, scale, proportion, rhythm, illusion of space and motion
- Established curriculum; prepared syllabus, lectures, projects and assignments
- Lectures on Drawing, Painting, Print making and Sculpture: key elements, references in art history with practical approaches and techniques
- Demonstrated methods and procedures; Drawing from observation, painting, print-making, paper sculpture
- Observed and evaluated students' work in order to determine progress

- Topics covered: 2D Design, line, shape, texture, color theory, value and contrast, unity and variety, balance, weight, gravity, scale, proportion, rhythm, illusion of space and motion, Gestalt elements
- Concepts covered: Creative problem solving, collaboration, brainstorming, convergent vs. divergent and critical thinking
- Adobe Creative Suite Software: Photoshop and Illustrator. Students developed their knowledge of each software through assigned projects

Studio sessions in direct observation of the figure and still life. Classes progressed in a logical manner building on the experience of the students while providing context and background, including references in art history
